1. Superintendent Pat Deklotz gave a short presentation about the upcoming referendum. She answered any questions and encouraged everyone to get out and vote April 1st.
2. Minutes: Minutes from the February meeting were approved. Amy apologized that she is missing some recent email addresses due to her computer crashing recently. Please be sure to include your email addresses on the sign-in sheet.
3. Treasurer's Report: Total current assets are \$32,705.77 and total liabilities are \$11,712.36 for a working total tonight of ~\$20,000.
4. Concession Stand Use Requests:
 - a. Boys Basketball Tournament – 6/14. This will NOT be a rental, so we will set up a SUG for volunteers closer to that date.
5. Funding Requests:
 - a. Prom: Cindy Zuelke submitted a letter requesting our traditional contribution to this event. As \$ is accrued for this, this is approved for \$1000.
 - b. Boys Basketball: Requests \$4000 for 4 coaches (\$1800 for a freshman coach and \$750x3 for additional coaches). This was approved.
 - c. Girls Basketball: Requests \$1800 for a freshman coach. This was approved.
 - d. Girls Soccer: Requests \$786 for uniforms (Athletic Director pays for other half). This was approved.
 - e. Boys Hockey: Requests \$1800 for a coach. This was approved.
6. Concession Stand Updates/Concerns:
 - a. Freezer for upper stand: We need additional freezer space in the upper stand. Gail found a simple upright freezer for ~\$535 at Walmart. This was approved.
 - b. Opening lower stand: Last fall the lower stand was closed quickly due to weather, before we could get it cleaned. Thus there will be some heavy cleaning and stocking to be done when we open this spring. Opening date depends on weather and when the water is turned on. We will need 10-12 volunteers. Date to be determined.

7. Upcoming Events:
 - a. Lake Country Fest: 3/29. This is a community fest where local vendors and businesses promote their services. There is a SUG and the first shift is filled but there are ~no volunteers for the 2nd shift (1-4pm). Please help us out!
 - b. Trivia Night: 3/22. Booster Club has sponsored a table (\$250) but it has yet to be filled. This table is available to anyone who can find a group of 8 to fill it! Please let Dan know if you are interested – no charge!
 - c. Regional Track Meet: 5/27. This will be a huge event, so look for a SUG soon and sign up!
 - d. Life of an Athlete: 3/25. John Underwood will be at Sheraton Hotel in Brookfield. We will be sending 20 freshmen and sophomores to hear his message that day. 3/26 he will be at KMHS. From 1-2:30 he will be speaking at the school and all students should try to attend (will need to fill out a Field Trip form to be excused from class). From 3-4:30 he will meet with coaches. From 7-8:30 he will be in the West gym for parents, students, community members and anyone interested.
8. Coaches' Concerns: None.
9. Old Business:
 - a. We STILL NEED a secretary and treasurer to step up for next year.
10. New Business:
 - a. Special Events Liaison: We would like to find someone for this position, to help coordinate concessions for special events. They would act sort of as an assistant to Gail Weber. Anyone interested, please see Gail.
 - b. Spring sports: Please get your liaison information to Gail. She will be setting up training sessions soon.
