1. Minutes: Minutes from the April meeting were approved.
2. Treasurer's Report: Total current assets are \$16,635.84 and total liabilities are \$14,537.36. More \$ turned in tonight from the spring raffle fundraiser.
3. Concession Stand Use Requests:
 - a. Basketball Tournament – 6/28-29 using all 3 gyms. We will open the indoor stand for this event. Look for a SUG.
4. Funding Requests:
 - a. Girls Track: Requesting \$4350 for coach funding. As volunteering and attendance are good - request approved.
 - b. Boys and Girls Golf: Requesting \$860 for 12 golf bags (total cost was \$1308 but only requesting part of this). Volunteering and attendance good – request approved.
 - c. Golf Outing: 6/1/14. We have traditionally donated \$500 to this event (for Tshirts). All funds go directly back to the Athletic Department. This was approved again for this year.
5. Concession Stand Updates/Concerns:
 - a. Baseball stand to open soon.
6. Upcoming Events:
 - a. Conference Track Meet: 5/19/14. Still need 2 more volunteers.
 - b. Regional Track Meet: 5/27/14. Still need help 7-9pm shift.
 - c. Kohl's Kicking Camp: 7/19-20/14. This is a huge event that can potentially bring in \$6000-8000. Look for a SUG this summer.
 - d. Relay For Life of Lake Country: 6/13/14. This event will be held at KM. It was decided not to open the stand as there will be only about 50 participants and a donation back to the organization is customary.
7. Coaches' Concerns: None.
8. Old Business:
 - a. Popcorn Wagon: After much back and forth, it was decided to NOT purchase the popcorn wagon. The purchase price of \$7000 is too much. That money is better spent going directly to teams. Mike Fink has acquired a shed, similar to the "Sugar Shack", that can be repainted and possibly fitted with wheels to serve as an additional small concession stand. With a portable generator, we could hopefully serve popcorn, cold drinks and maybe hot dogs from this location. It will be able to be moved around the KM campus, but not off-site.
