1. Minutes: Minutes from previous meeting were approved.
2. Treasurer's Report: Total current assets are \$8121.79 and total liabilities are \$2819.36. Mike has an additional \$3000 to hand in to Joanne. We owe track \$8300 that was previously approved.
3. Concession Stand Use Requests: None.
4. Funding Requests: None.
5. Concession Stand Updates:
  - a. We use the upper stand for storage and stocking of the other stands. If you use it, please leave it as you found it. There are some rentals using the stand over the summer and it needs to be in a usable and clean condition.
6. Upcoming Events:
  - a. Kohls Kicking Camp: 7/20-21. We expect ~450 athletes and ~900-1000 spectators, so this will be a huge event. We will be organizing volunteers for concessions soon. Watch for a Sign Up Genius.
7. Coaches' Concerns: None.
8. Old Business:
  - a. Boys VB: They are still working on selling their additional laser cards. Reminder that if they don't want to sell their cards, they can just make a donation.
9. New Business:
  - a. Black Canyon Coffee: BC Coffee has agreed to donate their Altera coffee to any sporting events we wish. This was started with the spring sports this year. If anyone wishes to use their coffee, this needs to be coordinated through Madeline Timm. In exchange for their generous donations, we will purchase a nice sign to display, advertising their product.
  - b. Mobile popcorn wagon: The school district wants to sell their mobile popcorn wagon that has been used for the Summer Academy. It is worth ~\$17,000

and they will sell it for \$7000. It has been inspected by Badger Popcorn and deemed "a steal". It is quite large, has 2 counters and a cooler and is powered by a generator. We would use it on the visitor's side of the field as a third concession stand. It could also be rented out by teams and taken to various community events for additional fundraising. There are a few unanswered concerns: 1) where to store it?, 2) additional insurance needed?. This issue was tabled until next month and hopefully by then we will have more info.

- c. Golf Outing: This event was very successful and make \$23,000 profit.
- d. Sue Tenhover has retired. Mamie Bishop will be taking her duties over.
- e. Liaison Coordinator: Bev Waltz will be in charge of tabulating the volunteer hours from now on. Thanks Bev!
